AVALANCHE DANGER

The southern Madison and southern Gallatin Ranges, the Lionhead Area near West Yellowstone, the mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range: avalanche danger is rated **HIGH** on all recently wind-loaded slopes or any slope steeper than 35 degrees. Lower angled terrain has a **CONSIDERABLE** danger.

The northern Madison Range: the avalanche danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all slopes.

The Bridger and northern Gallatin Ranges: wind loaded slopes have a **CONSIDERABLE** avalanche danger. Non wind loaded slopes have a **MODERATE** avalanche danger.
