

Fish Identification—Nonnative

Lake Trout—LT

All lake trout **MUST BE KILLED** in Yellowstone Lake.

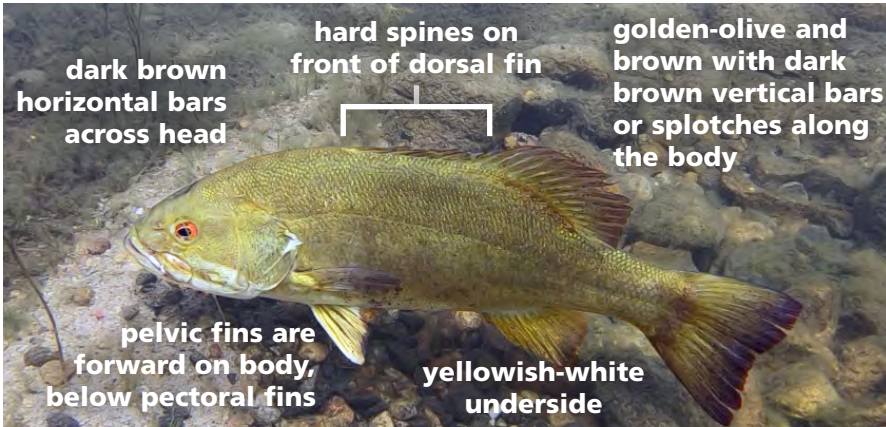
If you do not want to keep the fish, puncture the air bladder and drop it into water as deep as possible. In the backcountry, dispose of fish entrails and remains in fast moving or deep water. Do not discard trout carcasses along streams as they will attract bears.



Distributed in Heart, Lewis, Shoshone, and Yellowstone lakes.

Smallmouth Bass—SB

All smallmouth bass **MUST BE KILLED AND REPORTED** parkwide.

Smallmouth bass are a member of the Sunfish family of fishes which are not native to the park and are aggressive predators. Catchable smallmouth bass can be from 4 to 20 or more inches long.
