
Fish Identification—Native

Cutthroat Trout—CT



Cutthroat trout subspecies

Two subspecies of cutthroat trout are found in Yellowstone: the westslope cutthroat and the Yellowstone cutthroat (which has both large- and finespotted varieties). All fish with a red slash are considered cutthroat (or cutthroat/rainbow hybrids).

If it has a red slash, put it back.
