For the Bridger Range, danger is rated **HIGH** on all wind loaded slopes, **COSIDERABLE** on non wind loaded slopes steeper than 35 degrees and, **MODERATE** on non wind loaded slopes less than 35 degrees.

The northern Madison, and northern Gallatin Ranges, mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all wind loaded slopes and non wind loaded slopes steeper than 35 degrees and **MODERATE** on less steep slopes that have not received wind loading.

In the southern Madison Range, southern Gallatin Range and the Lionhead area near West Yellowstone danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all wind loaded slopes and non wind loaded slopes steeper than 35 degrees and **MODERATE** on non wind loaded slopes and slopes less than 35 degrees
