For the Bridger Range avalanche danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all wind loaded slopes. On slopes without a wind load, the danger is **MODERATE**, which means it's still possible to trigger avalanches. In Northern Madison and northern Gallatin Ranges, the mountains around Cooke City and the Washburn Range avalanche danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all wind-loaded slopes steeper than 35 degrees and **MODERATE** on all other terrain.

For the southern Madison Range, southern Gallatin Range and the Lionhead area near West Yellowstone the avalanche danger is rated **CONSIDERABLE** on all wind-loaded slopes and all slopes steeper than 35 degrees and **MODERATE** on slopes less than 35 degrees that were not affected by the wind.
